## Information on acceptance for doctoral studies at Faculty 1 (status December 2022)

Doctoral candidates at Faculty 1 are accepted in three steps:

- 1. registration on C@MPUS
- 2. application for acceptance at the Graduate Academy GRADUS
- 3. application for acceptance by the doctoral committee of Faculty 1.

Step 3 requires, in addition to the documents submitted to GRADUS in step 2, the submission of an exposé to the Dean's Office of Faculty 1.

Exposés should be approximately 10 pages long and cover the following topics:

- 1. abstract
- 2. topic of the doctorate
- 3. relevance of the topic
- 4. brief description of the current state of research
- 5. objectives, research questions and/or hypotheses
- 6. planned research methods
- 7. planned scope and form of the results (e.g. monograph, publications, demonstrator, data sets)
- 8. If applicable, description of sources to be processed (e.g. databases, data sets, literature, archival documents, drawings, etc.).
- 9. description of required equipment, if applicable
- 10. work plan and timetable of the PhD agreement submitted to GRADUS
- 11. publication plan (for publication-based doctorates)
- 12. financing plan, if applicable
