

The faculty offers only two different kinds of courses

1. „Entwurf“ = design project (15 ECTS)

Online **application** process for the design project
web based one week before the semester start

2. „Seminar“ = lectures (6 ECTS)

NO ONLINE APPLICATION !!

choosing and applying for a place is only possible two weeks prior to the lecture period.

Usually students take 1 design studio and two seminars. This gives you 27 (15+6+6) ECTS credits. Additionally you will/can take language courses that give you either 7 (intensive course prior to the semester) or 3 ECTS (extensive course during semester)



course offer, application, exams...

The faculty does not have a specific course program regarding the individual semesters (first, second or third semester, etc.).

We have a so-called vertical system. That means we mix students from different years and different study programs in the same course.

Furthermore, in our faculty there are no recurring courses that are repeated every semester or year. The course program is created anew each semester. Therefore, at the time the Learning Agreements are created, it is unfortunately not yet possible to know exactly which courses will be offered in that semester.

There is a list of courses that are open to exchange students. However, this only contains the general module designations and, if applicable, the assignment to subject areas. The exact course content is then determined in each respective semester. The institutes develop a teaching topic and then assign it to one of the module containers on the list.

So when you write the learning agreement, please take modules according to your study program (Bachelor / Master) from the list that can be found at the incoming section of the faculty website:
